- 3. **Continued Enrollment 11th and 12th Grade Students.** M.S., Sec. 120.0752, Subd. 3: An eleventh or twelfth grade student who has been enrolled in a district and whose parent(s)/guardian(s) have moved to another district may continue in enrollment in the district. The superintendent of the serving (non-resident) district must complete and sign verification statement A below.
