Indian Education Cultural Coordinator

Isle Public Schools is seeking an Indian Education Cultural Coordinator to plan cultural events and activities, engage students in cultural learning, and support teachers in implementing culturally relevant state standards. Flexible work schedule dependent on needs and activities. Position runs during the school year only, 10-20 hours per week.

Engage with students, families, school staff, and tribal members to promote cultural and language learning initiatives. Participate in American Indian Parent Advisory Committee (AIPAC) meetings.

Directly teach children individually, in small groups, and/or in classroom settings.

Qualifications:

- Experience with Indigenous youth and knowledge of Ojibwe cultural traditions is required.
- Knowledge of Ojibwe language is preferred.
- Ability to pass a criminal background check.
